

INTRODUCTION TO THE SEMINAR

Referring to global agreements like Sendai Framework (2015), Sustainable Development Goals and the Climate Change Agreement, India has prepared a disaster management plan and policy comprising of early warning systems, cyclone shelters, saline embankments, capacity building of communities

Govt of India has aimed at making India Disaster resilient by 2030 with the aim of every preventable death should be averted. Therefore, professionals need to come forward in disaster preparedness, mitigation, response, and recovery in line with the country's commitment to Sendai Goals (2015-30).
